## Cookies

To make this Site and Services work properly, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device. Most big websites do this too.

## What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

## What types of cookies do we use?

We use two types of cookies: session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are temporary cookies that remain on your device until you leave the Site. Session cookies are essential to make our Site and the Services work correctly, as they enable you to move around our Site and use our features. Persistent cookies remain on your device for much longer or until you manually delete it (how long the cookie remains on your device will depend on the duration or "lifetime" of the specific cookie and your browser

settings). Persistent cookies help us recognise you as an existing user of our Site and/or the Services, so it's easier and convenient to return to our Site or interact with our Services without signing in again. In addition, persistent cookies also help us recognise you when you view a resource belonging to our website from another website (such as an advertisement) and help us record information about your web browsing habits during the lifetime of the persistent cookie.

### **What are cookies used for?**

We use cookies on our Site and Services to personalise your experience on our Site and Services, and to help speed up your future activities and experience on our Site and Services. We also use cookies to track, compile and analyse usage, navigational and other statistical information that allow us to understand how people use our Site and Services and to help us improve the structure and content of the Site and Services. The cookie-related information is not used to identify you personally.

### **What third-party cookies do we use?**

We work with third-party service providers who may also set cookies on our Site. These third-party service providers help us track and analyse your use of our Site and to optimise our Site to improve your user experience on the Site.
